

NOPNA General Meeting – 9/19/19

- Livable City Sunday Streets Update – Bob Barnwell
 - Background on Sunday Streets: 10 events / year sponsored by Livable Streets (a nonprofit)
 - September 22nd – Fell to Geary between Masonic and Fillmore (no music on Baker Street)
 - NOPNA will have two tables at the upcoming Western Addition Sunday Streets (9/22)
 - Sunday Streets to pass out maps of each of the vendors attending
- Nmovoula O'meara Statement
 - Background: Mother and SF Renter for 23 years. Background in documentary film and worked as a case worker for five years.
 - Focus on homelessness, mental health, and tenants' rights
- Supervisor Vallie Brown Statement
 - Current Supervisor; born and raised on Native American reservation in Utah. Background as an artist but became an activist in the Bay View and Lower Haight neighborhoods
 - Has passed 31 pieces of legislation over the last 14 months with a focus on the housing developments (400 Divis, 650 Divis, and 1450 Fulton). Proposed legislation to prevent the city government of San Francisco from spending any money in states that ban abortion.
- NOPNA Vision Zero Sub Committee Update
 - Vision Zero is an initiative that was created to eliminate all pedestrians and cyclist related major injuries / deaths. San Francisco adopted plan to try to eliminate by 2014 although safety issues continue to rise this year.

- NOPNA created a Vision Zero subcommittee to focus on maximizing safety within our borders.
- Two major recent focus areas
 - § Improving safety of traffic circle located at Lyon & McAlister
 - § Divisadero Pedestrian Safety improvements (from Turk to Page)
- Whenever a major project is proposed, the city will hold meetings for public input; plans generally come from planners /engineers carrying out a Traffic Study to determine the best solution
