- 21, 31 still not returned to service
- 4-20 not happening/but DPW is standing by in case there is cleanup needed.

Parklets? -

- Mayor Breed is pushing proposal to make parklets permanent

Dean believes MTA has plan to phase out some buslines (despite public positioning)

### **Luke Bornhemier <kidsafe GGP>**

- JFK will revert to be used by cars within 120 days of pandemic lifted?
- 2750 San Franciscans signed petition to extend slow street closures
- If nothing changes - JFK will revert to being car-free only on Sundays; some Saturdays

### **Shannon Hake; Mark Dreger - slow streets**

- Targeting which slow streets to target to preserve post-covid
- On permanent slow streets - aim is to be welcoming to cyclists of all ages and abilities.
- There won't be any changes to the existing Bike Network (but they consider slow streets part of the bike network)
- Enforcement: work with map providers to route people off slow streets; considering signage for crossings/roadways.
